Mallala Township Connection Information

The Mallala Community Wastewater Management System (CWMS) is ready to accommodate house connections. Please contact Council on 8527 0200 or info@apc.sa.gov.au.

Important Information

All plumbing connection works must be undertaken by a registered plumber.

- It is suggested that the property connection applications are completed by a registered plumber.
- The connection fee \$218.00, this fee is associated with application and approval under the SA Public Health Legislation.

Properties with septic tanks older than 5 years (from date of installation) or have failed systems, must connect.

Properties with Aerated Wastewater Treatment Systems (AWTS) must connect within 10 years (from date of installation).

Existing on-site wastewater system (whether standard septic tank or AWTS) must be decommissioned to the satisfaction of council's Environmental Health Officer, which includes pumping out of sludge, and either removal of tank or the lid broken and tank filled with clean fill/rubble/sand.

The applicant must notify and provide Council with a minimum of 24 hours advanced notice of works, to enable and inspection to be conducted.

How to Connect

Before connection approval can be granted the following information must be provided to Council:

Completed and signed application to connect to the CWMS (On-site Wastewater Works application – available on website and can be collected from Mallala council Office).

Scaled site plan showing location of dwelling, boundaries, main drain and connection point on the property.

The application should be completed by registered Plumber is to include details of depth of connection point, and include, any other requirements of the On-Site Wastewater Systems Code.

Type, capacities and components of the proposed wastewater treatment system including any pump and/or pump sump, which will be connected to the CWMS.

Application fee of \$218.00
