## **OVERVIEW**

Members agreed to set a date for the official opening of the Mallala Museum’s Transport Gallery at its February 2023 APCHC meeting, ie Sunday afternoon, 28 May 2023 with the formal proceedings starting at 2 pm.

The Manager Library and Community attended the Museum’s final working bee before the ‘opening’ on Tuesday morning, 23 May 2023. It was pleasing to see a number of volunteers working on-site making final preparations, eg putting up Mallala Motorsport memorabilia in the Transport Gallery and on-going weeding. Professional cleaners were engaged to remove bird droppings from the ‘open’ Agricultural Shed and Transport Gallery. At the time of writing this report there is a reasonable chance of showers to be forecasted on the day, so guests may well need to seek shelter in the Museum’s outside buildings.

The Manager Library and Community has taken on the role of MC on the day. Although 50 people have already replied they will be attending, as this function is also open to the general public, volunteers are catering for approximately 100 guests. Mr Dale Wilden, Manager Major Events, History Trust of South Australia, has agreed to be one of the guest speakers and his speech will focus on the History Festival and its significance particularly in rural/regional areas. Another local guest speaker is yet to be finalised. Mr Glen Dix will have the honour of cutting the ribbon, to be tied around one of the displays in the Transport Gallery, before afternoon tea is served.
