OVERVIEW

Each month Council's Finance staff provide a financial statement (**Attachment 1**) for Members to consider at their Committee meeting.

Receipted income totals \$529 – the bulk of this money was generated through visitors from the "*Blue Wattle*" tours. The Manager Library and Community has completed the first budget review for budget lines she is responsible for overseeing, and has made adjustments to reflect two unexpected expenses – this includes registration of the Museum's Fire Truck (\$478) and the annual CWMS connection charge (\$659).

A total of \$11,722 has been transferred from the Mallala Museum's bank account to Council's account, to reflect invoices Council paid for in the 2020/2021 financial, for the Transport Gallery refit.

EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

- The Adelaide Plains Council Historical Committee generally appoints its Office Bearers at its November annual general meeting.

DETAILED REPORT

Purpose
