That Council is satisfied that pursuant to section 90(3)(b) of the Local Government Act 1999, Item 4.1 Two Wells Town Centre Market Engagement Selection of Preferred Tender concerns commercial information the disclosure of which could reasonably be expected to confer a commercial advantage on a person with whom the council is conducting business, or to prejudice the commercial position of Council, being information relating to ongoing negotiations, and would on balance be contrary to the public interest;
- 3. That Council is satisfied that the principle that Council meetings should be conducted in a place open to the public has been outweighed by the need to keep the information, matter and discussion confidential."
