"that pursuant to Section 39(4)(d) of the *Development Act, 1993*, and Regulation 17(3)(a) of the *Development Regulations, 2008*, the Adelaide Plains Council Assessment Panel resolves not to proceed with an assessment of the application by Lucy Britton for the keeping of 2 horses, change of use of existing shed to stable, and the construction of a day yard and training arena (Non-Complying), at Lot 19, Fourth Street, Dublin, Hundred of Dublin (312/122/2018) for the following reasons:-

The proposal is at variance with the following Development Plan provisions:-

- The proposal is inconsistent with the Desired Character statement, PDC 7 and PDC 1 as it is not a desired land use within the Township Zone.
- Objective 4 further supports the provisions, as this type of activity is not listed within the
 Desired Character statement for the Township Zone and it is likely to have adverse
 impacts on the immediate locality and adjoining allotments.
- The Non-Complying provisions list this type of activity as being non-complying with no exceptions, with PDC 2 further supporting this provision."
