Re: Advance Notice – Landscape Works

Please note Council will be conducting works within the three existing Dublin main street garden beds.

Works will include the removal of all existing understory vegetation to allow for a blank canvas and provide an aesthetically pleasing streetscape. The majority of the existing Eucalyptus will remain, with only the dead, sick and out of place trees being removed.

Council will be conducting work within the southernmost garden bed before the end of the 2018/2019 financial year.

The southern bed will be cleared of all existing vegetation and planted with the same or similar species of tree which are currently present in the other two garden beds.

Small gardens will be situated at the ends of each bed keeping vehicle line of site, aesthetics and appropriateness in mind.

Due to the close proximity to the road no seating or tables will be provided within the median strip. There will however, be cross over paths for pedestrians to utilise when crossing the road.

Council will endeavor to ensure any inconveniences are kept to a minimum.
